



Nick La Riviere and The Best Laid Plans Returns With Instrumentally Dense Ballad ‘Where We Go’

Lead single “Where We Go” from the upcoming album “Get Ready!” is the latest release from Victoria-based R&B/jazz outfit **Nick La Riviere and The Best Laid Plans**. La Riviere, who is the lead vocalist as well as a recognised trombonist, is joined by six other exciting jazz instrumentalists from the Victoria area. As “Where We Go” commences, you’re greeted by a poetically curated piano loop that harnesses your undivided attention from the outset.

As the chords progress effortlessly, Nick La Riviere’s vocal capability presents itself in a soulful and sincere manner - much like the incredibly subtle organ played by Attila Fias, an instrumental choice that tastefully adds to and highlights the soul-influenced aspects of the song.

The lyrics build simultaneously with the percussion, reaching an atmospheric climax before rolling over into the rest of the song. La Riviere’s lyrics invoke emotion, liberation and transparency throughout. This, paired with the light-hearted intensity of the production, makes for a fantastic track filled with technical ability from both La Rivière and his band, The Best Laid Plans.

“Where We Go” is a solid indication of the type of dynamic qualities this 7-man-band possess, mixing influences of pop, jazz and R&B to create a powerful end product.
